

Software Update (CN201)

This document contains instructions for updating the system software of the Kawai CN201 digital piano. Please read these instructions thoroughly before attempting to perform the software update.

The update process will require approximately 7 minutes to complete.

■ Checking the current software version

While the CN201 digital piano is turned off:

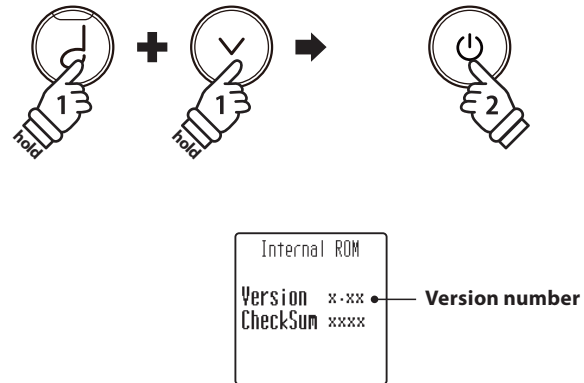
Press and hold the [] and [] buttons simultaneously, then press the [] (POWER) button to turn the instrument on.

The current software version will be shown in the LCD display.

If the version number is **greater than** or equal to the update version, no further action is necessary.

* Turn the instrument off and on to return to normal operation.

If the version number is **lower than** the update version, please continue to follow the instructions below.



■ Update requirements

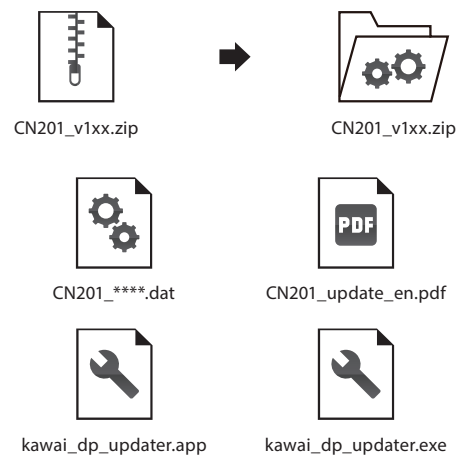
This stage of the software update will require a Windows or macOS computer with internet access, and a USB type "B" to type "A" cable.

■ Preparing for the update

After downloading the software update zip file, extract the contents to a temporary folder (e.g. the Desktop).

The folder should contain four files.

Filename	Description
CN201_****.dat	CN201 system software
CN201_update_en.pdf	Update instructions
kawai_dp_updater.app	Update tool for macOS
kawai_dp_updater.exe	Update tool for Windows

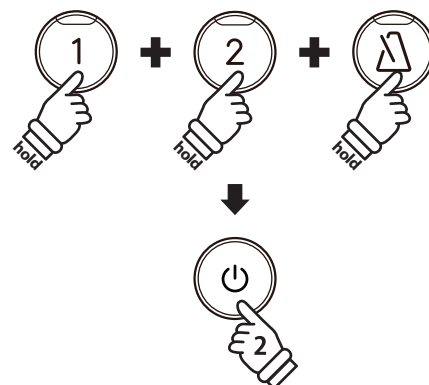


1. Turn on the piano in update mode

While the CN201 digital piano is turned off:

Press and hold the [], [], and [] buttons simultaneously, then press the [] (POWER) button to turn the instrument on.

The piano will turn on in update mode, and the LED indicators for the three pressed buttons will start to flash.

2. Connect the piano to the computer

Connect the piano to the computer using a USB type "B" to USB type "A" cable.

* Please refer to page 33 of the main CN201 owner's manual for more information.



3. Launch the Kawai DP Updater tool

Launch the Kawai DP Updater tool on the Windows or macOS computer.



4. Select the update file and MIDI Out device

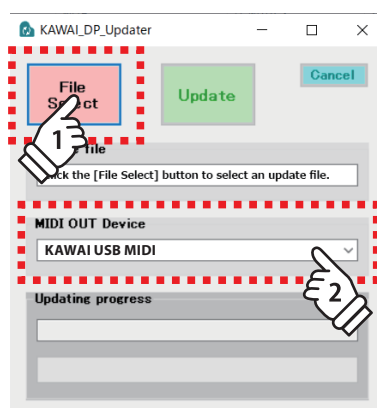
From the Kawai DP Updater tool window:

Click the [File Select] button, then select the **CN201_****.dat** update file.

* The file should be stored in the temporary folder on the desktop.

Click the MIDI Out Device list and select [KAWAI USB MIDI].

* Note that the position of the USB-MIDI device within the list may vary if other MIDI devices are also connected to the computer.



5. Start the update process

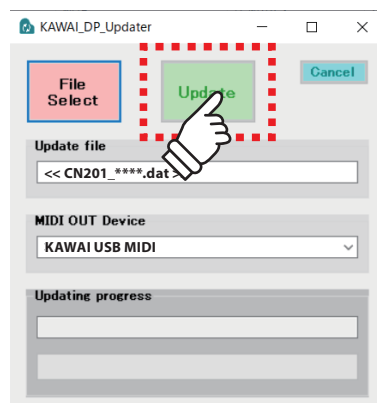
From the Kawai DP Updater tool window:

Click the [Update] button to start the software update process.

* The software update will take approximately 7 minutes to complete. The update progress will be shown in the bottom of the window.

* During the update, do not use or attempt to launch other applications, and ensure that the Kawai DP Updater tool remains the front-most window.

* During the update, the LED indicators for different buttons will continue to flash, however do not turn off the piano.



6. Finish the update

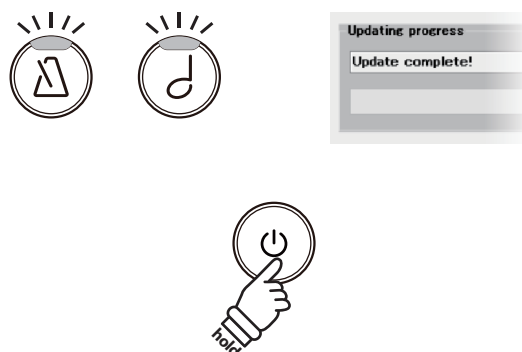
After approximately 7 minutes, the LED indicators for the [Δ] and [D] buttons will start to flash, and an [Update complete!] message will be shown in the Kawai DP Updater tool window.

Disconnect the USB cable, then press and hold the [⏻] (POWER) button for 2 seconds to turn the instrument off.

Perform the software version check (explained on the first page of these instructions) to confirm that the update was successful.

When the instrument is turned on, the updated software will be used automatically.

* If this stage of the update is unsuccessful, please restart from step 1.



Software Update (CN201)

■ CN201 System software changelog

V1.0.10 (July 2025)

- Fixed: The Bluetooth MIDI device name was set incorrectly in some regions.
- Changed: Pressing the [UP] and [DOWN] buttons simultaneously while on the Bluetooth settings screen will set Bluetooth to the default value of Off.

V1.0.9 (April 2025)

- Changed: Performing a Factory Reset will now restore the Bluetooth setting to the default value of Off.

V1.0.8 (March 2025)

- Changed: In accordance with RE regulations, the default setting for Bluetooth MIDI/Audio is now set to Off.

V1.0.7 (February 2025)

- Changed: In accordance with ErP regulations, a message will be displayed when the Auto Power Off setting is changed to a non-default value. (For European destinations only).

V1.0.6 (July 2024)

- Internal release.

V1.0.5 (May 2023)

- Fixed a bug that could cause a note to sound when the key was not played.

V1.0.4 (February 2023)

- Fixed an issue with occasional "Update Required" dialog box appearing when connecting to the PianoRemote app via Bluetooth MIDI.

V1.0.3 (November 2022)

- Fixed a rare problem in which stopping a recording while pressing a key would corrupt the recorder data.

V1.0.2 (August 2022)

- Fixed an issue where the Bluetooth icon would appear even on instruments with Bluetooth disabled.
- Fixed the Sound envelope table for Concert magic mode.
